

When provisions clothing &c are
 supplied to the Indians, full
 explanations should be given
 to the mother, as such relief
 is only to be given to the
 sick and destitute who are
 unable to provide for themselves
 and not to other bodily Indians.

The Department considers that
 a difference should be made
 in the allowance to the Agent
 for her services as interpreter
 when she has not to leave
 the Agency and when it is
 necessary for her to go and
 the extent and duration in
 such services should be stated.

In many cases it would seem
 that her services should not be
