
Ottawa Dec 6th, 1910

Sir,-

Referring to the last paragraph of your letter of the 22nd ultimo I have to say that as the Michel Indian Reserve has not as yet been subdivided for Indian occupation and that such a subdivision may be possible at some date in the future, we are unable to state the number of crossings that may be required.

I have to request that your Resident Engineer will be good enough to consult Mr. Urban Verreau, Indian Agent, Edmonton, Alta, as to the number and position of crossings required at present.
