In reply to your letter of the 23rd instant regarding the account in favour of Mr. J.T. Brown for services in a liquor case, which was submitted by Mr. Van Loon for payment, I beg to say that in view of your statement that Mr. Brown was paid by the day for his services and that his expenses were allowed, the Department agrees with you that the account should not be paid.
