I am directed to inform you that you have been appointed medical officer to the Indians of Treaty No. 10 during the summer months this year, and your remuneration will be at the rate of \$2.00 a day and expenses.

Mr. Inspector Chisholm will advise you as to the place you should report to the paying officer, Mr. E.A. Bennett, at Prince Albert.

Your pay will commence from the date you leave this place to report to Mr. Bennett and end on the date you return.

Mr. Chisholm will order the drugs required for the trip on receipt of a requisition from you.

You will be subject to Mr. Bennett's orders and instructions.
