Sir,

Referring to your letter of Dec. 6, last, and enclosure, No. 258-4, I beg to inform you that we have received a valuation from Indian Agent, Mr. J. C. P. Day, Battleford, Sask., of the right of way required by the C. T. P. Rwy. through the Sweet Grass Indian reserve. Mr. Day has placed the value at \$15. per acre and it appears there are no Indian improvements affected. He also states that your local agent considers this valuation to be fair one.

The total area taken is 93.35 acres at \$15.00 per acre equals \$1400.25; I have to request you to be good enough to have the said sum forwarded to the Department.
