It appears that Ira Sampson contracted diphtheria. You will observe that the doctor has suggested moving this boy from the school to the home of Mrs. Bellamy, and the Department has agreed to the arrangement. If Mrs. Bellamy charges for the boy's maintenance and care, you should see that the charge in the case is made at a reasonable rate. You should report as to whether she is a relative of this boy.
