security to Josiah Miller. My brother Seth and I executed a Quit Claim deed to Josiah Miller (Exhibit A.) dated 17th.

Jany. 1896, the consideration being Forty Five dollars. As I had an interest in the property Seth could not sell it without my joining. I claimed half the undivided interest in the property before Seth died. The money Josiah Miller gave was paid to my brother Seth but I received none of it.

I paid the Forty Five dollars, with interest, making in all Fifty One dollars & Thirty Five cents (\$51.35) and received from him a Quit Claim deed dated 13th. November 1897 (Exhibit B). I have been living on this property since a year last June..

Cross Examined by Mr. Bowlby ...

- Q. Did Seth claim the whole of this land when he was living.
- A. No he never claimed the whole of this land.
- Q. Do you know when Seth and your mother made a will?
- A. No. I do not know anything about it.
- Q. Did amybody on behalf of these boys, Jacob & John, offer you back all the money you paid, with interest at 10%?
- A. Yes. Jacob offered me the money and I refused it.
- Q. Did you ever hear of a will being made by your mother of this property?
- A. No I never heard of any will until now.
- Q. Did your mother tell you what interest you had in the land?
- A. My mother always told me that I have a half interest in the property.
