administration to supplement the previous governor general's warrants by amounts necessary to meet requirements for the months of October and November for the salaries of public officials and for the financing of contracts, works, and so forth, which it found the country obligated to carry on. To meet such expenditures warrants were issued in October for \$15,612,796.74, and in November for \$16,350,712.97, or a total of \$31,963,509.71. Expenditures for the corresponding months of the previous year were \$30,497,921.52. Thus, the total amount of governor general's warrants issued during the year amounted to \$80,671,982.82, while the total expenditures for similar services—as covered by the governor general's warrants—for the corresponding period of the year before was \$79,500,000, or a million less than the total warrants.
