3 schools of thought;

3 policies in conflict;

(1) Imperialism (thoroughgoing) - Imperialistic

a common commonwealth policy of defence and
foreign policy;

(2) Isolation (thoroughgoing) - isolationist
(regardless nationalism)

withdrawal from Commonwealth ^{and} internal entanglements;

(3) Middle Course - Canadian policy
