

- A. Outside in the yard.
- Q. About how far from the billet?
- A. About 100 yards.
- Q. What was he doing?
- A. Working on a crane motor.
- Q. Did he give you a cigarette of any kind?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Not even one of any kind?
- A. No sir.

Witness re-examined by the Prosecution

- Q. This cigarette issue on the first of August. How many times had you been issued with cigarettes in this manner before?
- A. Never.
- Q. Were your cigarettes wrapped like that before this issue?
- A. No sir.
- Q. When did you get this issue?
- A. On the 6th August, the day before this took place. I had been on leave.

President of the Court

- Q. You did the reporting to the QMS that three people in your hut had lost cigarettes?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Before this you must have had a conversation with the other two?
- A. Yes.
- Q. How many were lost altogether?
- A. Myself 800, Stanley 400 and Pierce 300.
- Q. What sort of cigarettes did Pierce lose?
- A. Buckingham.
- Q. What did Stanley lose?
- A. Buckingham.
- Q. Did he tell you that?
- A. No sir. Pierce told me Buckingham but Stanley made no mention of the brand. He was issued with Buckingham.
- Q. What were the brand under the stairs?
- A. British Consols.

Judge Advocate

- Q. Will you look at Exhibit "THREE" please. Is that an accurate representation of Hut 18?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Will you mark with a "Z" the room you were in to watch what went on?
- A. That is it there (witness marks on Exhibit).
- Q. Mark with a "Y" the window you were looking out?
- A. (Witness marks window). That window looks out to the
