

BIG GAME

The upper reaches of the Kootenay River north of the Banff-Windermere road are filled with big game such as moose, goat, deer and bear, and good fishing, while south of the Banff Windermere road are to be found moose, elk, mountain sheep (Big Horn) goat, mule white-tail deer, grizzly and black bear. The resorts where these animals may be found can be reached in from two to four days from Invermere, the journey being an easy one with pack and saddle horses.

I have been guiding and outfitting in this district for the past twenty years and carry a large range of pack horses and equipment and am prepared to take out parties of hunters or tourists.
