- assent by seller to buyer's disposition by issue of negotiable, 993, 1000
- authority to receive possession, is only, 243, 844
- certificate, warehouseman's, distinguished, 977
 - that goods "ready for delivery," 991
- conversion by transfer of, by pledgee, 983
- defined, 44, 977
- delivery, as effecting. *See* DOCUMENT OF TITLE.
- delivery order distinguished, 977
- document of title under Factors Act, a, 44

WARRANTY,

GENERALLY,

- breach of, pleaded in diminution of price, 112^a, 1132
 - no excuse for non-acceptance, 1124
 - condition, breach of, may be treated as breach of, 639, 644
 - when it must be so treated, 640, 644
 - implied, or condition excluded by inconsistent, express, 746, 747
 - damages for breach of, 1142 *et seqq.* *See* DAMAGES.
 - description distinguished from, 640
 - Scotland, meaning in, of, 646
 - specific goods, statement descriptive of, generally only a, 640
- EXPRESS, 750-771
- definition of, 750, 751
 - part of contract, must be, 751-753, 755
 - after sale requires fresh consideration, 753
