The Restoration proposed is a simple and practical one, which can be immediately begun, and which would preserve the memories of this historic spot for the education of our youth, be a reverend Memorial to the men who gallantly served our country and be an attraction to the travelling public and for the enjoyment of our own Citizens.

These Plans are respectfully submitted by the Ontario Historical Society to the Historical and Military Societies for their consideration.
