few bags of spices while boiling.

Grape Pie.—Use very ripe black grapes.
Line a deep pie dish with rich crust, then
put in the grapes and sugar. Cut cross
slits across the top crust, put it on the
pie, and turn back the corners to form
an open square in the middle of the pie.
Place in a quick oven, and while baking
make a sauce of $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter, 1 cup
sugar and 1 tablespoon boiling water.
Stir well over hot water and flavor with
lemon juice or nutmeg. When the pie is
nearly baked take it out, pour in the
sauce and return to the oven. Serve
hot.

Recipes.

Jellied Tongue.—Boil the tongue until
tender, so that the skin will pull off
easily. Cut in thin slices, and arrange
in a mould previously lined with thin
slices of lemon. Cover with a jelly made
