It is only Christ who can give this living water; and we must each one go and ask Him for it, as the woman at the well did, "Give me this water, that I thirst not;" give me Thyself, that in me there may be springing up a well of water unto everlasting life. God grant it for Iesus Christ's sake. Amen.


