ST. LAWRENCE CANALS. RAPIDE PLAT DIVISION.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS.


SEALED TENDERS addressed to the under-signed, and endorsed "Tender for the St. Lawrence Canals," will be received at this office, until the arrival of the eastern and western mails on Wednesday, the 23rd day of July next, for the construction of a lift lock, weirs, etc., at Morris-burg, and the deepening and enlargement of the Rapide Plat Canal. The work will be divided into three sections, each about a mile in length. A map of the locality, together with plans and specifications of the respective works, can be seen on and after Wednesday, the 5th day of July next, on and after Wednesday, the 9th day of July next, at this office, and at the Resident Engineer's Office, Morrisburg, where printed forms of tender

can be obtained. In the case of firms there must be attached to the tender the actual signatures of the full name, the nature of the occupation and residence of che nature of the occupation and residence of each member of the same, and further, an ac-cepted cheque on a chartered bank in Canada for the sum of \$6,000, must accompany the tender for Section No. 1, and an accepted cheque on a chartered bank in Canada for the sum of \$2,000, for each of the other sections. The respective accented cheques must be en-

The respective accepted cheques must be en-dorsed over to the Minister of Railways and Canals, and will be forfeited if the party tender-ing declines entering into contract for the works at the rates and on the terms stated in the offer submitted. The cheques thus sent in will be re-turned to the respective parties whose tenders are not accepted. This Department does not, however, bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.
