LANCASTER, Pa., Nov. 1.—The police are to-day seeking an unknown rider of a motor cycle who sped through Lancaster and Williamstown late last night discharging a revolver wildly among hallowe'en crowds, and who is believed to be responsible for the killing of two persons. One of the victims is sixteen yearold Ivan Graeff, who was with a
