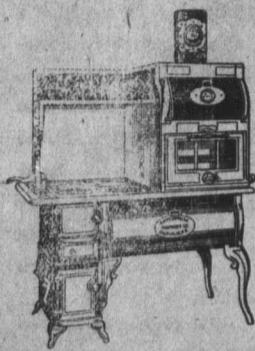

These and other arguments are used by advocates of crushing oats for horses. Big British Steamer Sunk

LONDON, Jan. 29—Lloyd's shipping agency today announced the sinking of the British steamship *Matheran*, of 7,654 tons gross.

The captain and crew of the vessel were landed. The *Matheran* was 470 feet long, built in Belfast in 1906, and was owned by N. and J. Brocklebank, Ltd., of Liverpool.

Lloyd's also announced that the Norwegian steamship *Dnstad* of 698 tons gross had been sunk. The Russian steamer *Egret* was posted as "believed sunk."

The crew of the Norwegian steamer *Theresdal*, 1762 tons gross, sunk by a German submarine, has arrived at Las Palmas, says a Reuters despatch from that Canary Island port today. The captain was held a prisoner on board the submarine.
