**From Bathurst To  
Plaster Rock**

FREDERICTON, April 1—  
In the Provincial Legislature  
yesterday afternoon, Premier  
Veniot presented a petition  
in favor of a bill to incorpo-  
rate the Nepisiguit Railway  
Company, which will give the  
incorporators charter rights  
to build a railway from near  
Bathurst across the province  
to Plaster Rock, to open up  
the most extensive hardwood  
limits in New Brunswick.

The new organization will  
be allied with the Bathurst  
Company, Limited. Proposal  
are to replace the rails on the  
Northern New Brunswick  
Seaboard Railway, the line  
leading from a connection  
with the Canadian National  
Railways near Bathurst to  
the Gloucester iron mines,  
and the petition sets forth the  
route to be followed by the  
railway as from near Austin  
Brook along the Nepisiguit  
River to 40 mile brook and  
thence west to a point on the  
Tobique river near Plaster  
Rock. The petition pointed  
out that the object of this  
railway is to "open up the  
vast hardwood area" and  
authority is asked to operate  
the railway by either steam  
or electricity.

The Nepisiguit Railway  
Company will have its head-  
quarters in Fredericton and  
will hold its annual meetings  
here each April 15 it will have  
an authorized capitalization  
of \$1,000,000, and will have  
authority to issue 6 per cent  
bonds up to an amount equal  
to \$25,000 per mile. Peter  
J. Hughes, K. C., of this city  
is solicitor for the new com-  
pany and he and two of his  
office clerks are the nominal  
incorporators.

The bill provides that actual  
work on the construction of  
the railway shall commence  
within three years and  
that if it is not completed  
within ten years the charter  
rights to the the uncompleted  
portions shall lapse.

**Game Act  
Amendments  
Are Coming**

Amendments to the Game  
Act are contemplated and a  
bill including them will be  
presented to the House of As-  
sembly as a Government mea-  
sure in the near future.

One of the provisions will  
be prohibition of the trapping  
or hunting of bears in the for-  
ests between May 1 and Sept.  
1. The provision is intended  
to protect the forests against  
fires and also to prevent illicit  
trapping of beaver by persons  
entering the forests ostensibly  
for trapping bears. Violation  
of the Game Act in that par-  
ticular has occurred in the past  
and fires also have been caused  
by bear-trappers.

There is to be a section giv-  
ing permission to kill bear if  
they are molesting domestic  
animals and also permission  
to hunt them in open country.  
The provision allowing a  
ten-day hunting season for  
deer on Grand Manan and  
Campobello Islands is to be  
extended to include Deer Is-  
land. For a licence fee of one  
dollar permission is given to  
kill one deer.

In order to make it more  
difficult to evade the law in  
the matter of killing cow-  
moose or calf-moose, a provi-  
sion is to be contained in the  
bill under which the head of a  
moose must be brought out of  
the woods and shown to a


