EIGHT HOURS A DAY.

Interesting Discussion in the British Metropolis.

Between Mr. Charles Bradlaugh, M.P., and Mr. Hyndman, the Social Democrat.

A public discussion took place recently between Mr. Charles Bradlaugh, M.P., and Mr. Hyndman, the well-known Social Democrat, on the question of an eight-hour day. The ball is one of the largest in London, and it was crowded in every part by an audience mainly composed of, but by no means confined to, the working class. The audience appeared to be divided in fairly equal proportions between the followers and partisans of the disputants, and Mr. Sydney Buxton, M.P., presided. The discussion was conducted in a fairly orderly manner, and each speaker had as full an opportunity of expressing his views as was possible within the limits of a public meeting.

Mr. Hyndman, on rising to submit a case for an eight-hour day, was loudly cheered. He began by alluding to a number of well-known and generally accepted axioms. Nobody, he said, denied that overwork exists. The only question was in how far it was to be restricted. He submitted it could not be predicated to any industry to be carried on under conditions which degraded the vitality and intelligence of those who practiced it. Eight hours a day, he said, was too much for the health of workmen, and he therefore held that his proposal was a modern one. The laboring classes died at about half the age of those who lived upon a moderate and healthy diet.
