

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

N the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Customs, and under and in virtue of the authority given and conferred by the Act passed during the present Session of the Legislature, entitled "An Act respecting the Customs." His Excellency in Council has been pleased to make the following Re-Rulation:

"In addition to the Warehousing Ports mentioned in the Act passed during the present Session of the Farliament of Canada, and intiluled" An Act respecting the Castomay, And also in addition to the Ports named in a list sanctioned by an Order of His Excelency the Governor General in Council, of the 24th December, 1837, passed under the authority of the said Act, the following Ports be included in the List of Warehousing Ports in the Dominion, viz

Province of Ontario-Port of Gananoque, Port of Newcastie.

Province of Nova Scotia-Port of Hollin."


