Secondly. Thirdly. In course of time three of Ethelred's sons are put to death, one of them by the order of Sweyn's son Canute:

Fourthly. The only one of all his sons who leaves family has but two sons, of whom the one dies issueless, and the other without a male representative in the second generation. Thus m the fourth generation the name of Edgar's house is blotted from the list of the families of the earth. "The works of the Lord are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein." Psalm exi. 2.
