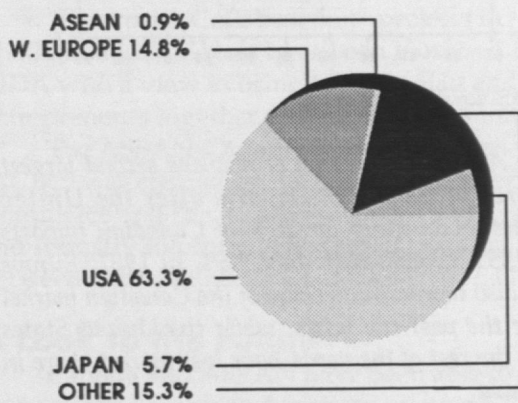

As part of a larger framework for economic co-operation, Canada and the ASEAN countries are involved with the Asia Pacific Economic

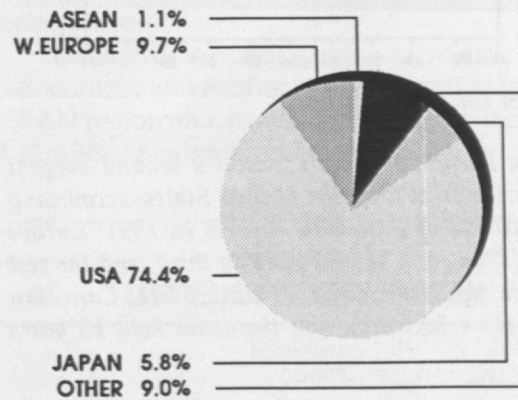

Since 1989, the 15 APEC member countries from Northeast and Southeast Asia, Australia, New Zealand, the U.S.A. and Canada have met annually to discuss global and regional economic issues. APEC Ministerial meetings have also created an informal opportunity for foreign and trade ministers from the region to discuss political issues.

**CANADA WORLD EXPORTS 1980**



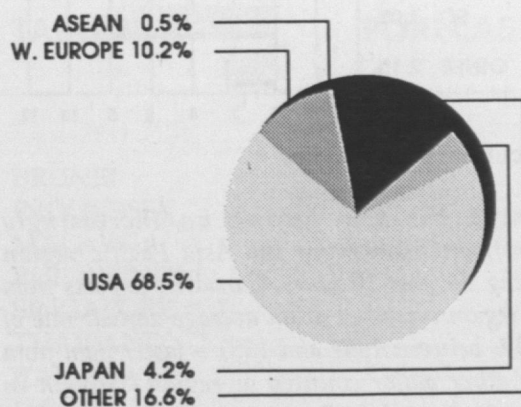

**CANADA WORLD EXPORTS 1990**



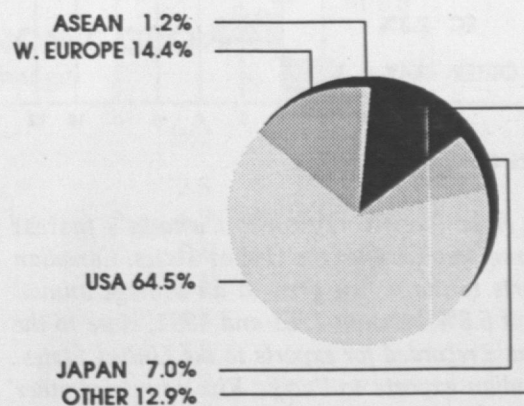
