ARTICLE 10

<u>Making of Detained Persons Available</u> to Give Evidence or Assist in Investigations in the Requesting State

- 1. A person detained in the Requested State shall, upon request, be transferred temporarily to the Requesting State to assist investigations or testify in proceedings, provided that the person consents.
- 2. When the person transferred is required to remain in custody under the law of the Requested State, the Requesting State shall keep this person in custody and shall return the person to the Requested State following execution of the request.
- 3. If the sentence imposed on the person transferred ends or if the Requested State informs the Requesting State that this person no longer has to be detained, that person shall be set at liberty and be treated as a person whose presence in the Requesting State was obtained pursuant to a request to this effect.

ARTICLE 11

Providing Evidence and Assisting in Investigations in the Requesting State

The Requested State shall invite a person to assist in an investigation or to appear as a witness in the Requesting State and shall seek that person's consent thereto. The Requesting State shall inform this person, in the request, of the expenses and allowances payable.

ARTICLE 12

Safe Conduct

- 1. Subject to paragraph 2 of Article 10, a person present in the Requesting State pursuant to a request made for this purpose shall not be prosecuted, detained or subjected to any other restriction of personal liberty in the Requesting State in respect of any acts or omissions which preceded that person's departure from the Requested State, nor shall that person be obliged to give evidence in any proceeding other than that to which the request relates.
- Paragraph 1 of this Article shall cease to apply where a person, being free to leave the Requesting State, has not left it within a period of 30 days after being officially notified that the person's attendance is no longer required or, having left that territory, has voluntarily returned.
- Any person who fails to appear in the Requesting State shall not be subjected to any penalty or compulsory measure in the Requested State or in the Requesting State.
