Dear Sir Arthur,

Since our conversation with Mr. Ross the other day on the subject of my firm's interest in the Gymnasium job, what may be called the broader aspects of the matter have been mentioned to me by mutual friends. On further consideration, and in view of my long association with the University and its development, I feel that I would prefer to waive all claims on behalf of my firm in this connection, based on understandings arrived at previous to your accession to the Principalship.

I should very much regret that any claims my firm has in this matter should be a cause of the least embarrassment as between the Governors and the Graduates.

In the event of a competition being instituted for the Gymnasium Building, strictly restricted to graduates of the University, my partner would expect equal consideration with other graduates.
