STAGE COACHES.



The Royal Western Stage Coaches, (carrying H. M. Mails) run
THREE TIMES in the week, between Halifax and Annapolis.

TIMES OF STARTING.

On Monday, Wednesday and Friday Mornings, leaves Kent-
ville for Halifax, and for Annapolis at 6 o'clock.

On Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday Mornings, leaves Halifax
and Annapolis for Kentville, at 6 o'clock.

The Royal Eastern Stage Coaches, (carrying H. M. Mails,) run three times in the week, between Halifax and Pictou.

TIMES OF STARTING.

The Pictou Coach will start at 6 o'clock, on the mornings of Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and arrive in Halifax the following day at 2 o'clock, p. m.

The Halifax Coach will start on the mornings of Monday and Friday at 6 o'clock, and arrive in Pictou next day, at 2 o'clock, p. m. On Wednesday the Coach will leave at 3 o'clock, p. m. and stop all night at Hill's Inn.

The above is the Summer arrangement—some alteration usually takes place in the times of leaving, &c. during the Autumn and Winter, as the state of the roads at those periods will not generally allow of the Summer arrangements being continued.

A Stage Coach also runs between Amherst and St. John, N. B. once in the week.

A Stage also runs daily between Miramichi and Bathurst, and another which leaves Miramichi with the Mails for Richibucto, Petticodiac and Dorchester every Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, and returns with the Mails to Miramichi on the morning of Saturday, this Stage meets at Dorchester the Couriers for Halifax and St. John.
