That hereafter all Dinners and Suppers of the Soicety be conducted without the use of Spirituous or Malt Liquors.

Rescinded at Annual Meeting, November, 1803.

Passed 4th August, 1887.

That hereafter refreshments of all kinds be dispensed with at Quarterly Meetings.

Rescinded 3rd May, 1888.

Passed 5th November, 1891.

SECTION 111.-That the seventh and ninth paragraphs of this section be omitted.

Passed 5th November, 1893.

Any ordinary member of the Society having paid dues for twenty years in succession, shall, at his own request, be entitled to Honorary Membership.

Passed 1st November, 1894.

That in future, the Senior Asst. Vice-President, with the Junior Asst. Vice act as Stewards of the Society, and are, by this by-law, fuily empowered to superintend the social interests of the members at the Quarterly Meetings, provide speakers and singers, and arrange for suitable refreshments.
