THE SENATE OF CANADA.

BILL RR.

An Act respecting The Brockville, Westport and North-western Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Brockville, Westport and North-western Preamble.
Railway Company has by its petition prayed that it be 1903, c. 88. enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the 1905, c. 64. prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and 1907, c. 67. with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The Brockville, Westport and North-western Railway Extension of Company may commence the construction of its railway and time for construction expend fifteen per cent of the amount of its capital stock thereon,

10 within two years after the passing of this Act, and may complete the said railway and put it in operation within five years after the passing of this Act; and if the said railway is not so commenced and such expenditure is not so made, or if the said railway is not completed and put in operation, within the said periods respectively, the powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects such portion of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.

2. Section 2 of chapter 67 of the statutes of 1907 is hereby Repeal of former 20 repealed.
