hour of the day; with this abfurdity added to injuffice, that they are alterable and revocable only on one fider that is to the injury of the Colonist for ever, and at no period of time to his benefit? And this without confidering, that by your own doctrine these charters, instead of being annulled as the ground of their independance, ought to be held facred and immutable as the source of your authority?

But not content with innovating charters, you advife that the Americans univerfally fhould be fubjugated by ftricter laws and ftronger obligations. You exhort that national vengeance may be poured on the contrivers of mifchief, and that no miftakes of clemency fhould prevent abundant forfeitures. Left this fhould not be fufficiently harfh and humiliating, you fuggeft, that their flaves may be taken from them, though, by your laws, their property, and fettled, with arms for their defence, in fome fimple,
