ber shall at any time have the right of again using the Club by notifying his intention so to do, and paying the subscription for the then current year. But if any member so removing his residence from Quebec, and taking advantage of this rule, shall again return to reside in Quebec, or nearer than sixty miles therefrom, he shall within one month from such return, notify the Secretary thereof, and pay the subscription for the then current year, and failing so to do, his name shall be struck from the roll of members, unless some good excuse be offered to the Committee to account for his neglect.

ART. 12.—Persons holding civil appointments under the Provincial Government, temporarily resident in Qubec, shall be eligible for election without payment of the entrance fee, but subject to the payment of an annual subscription of £10 or a semiannual subscription of £5. Members of the Legislature non-residents of Quebec, shall be eligible for election on payment of an annual Fee of £7. 10s.

ART. 13.—Consuls or representatives of any foreign power, and their attachés, not being permanent residents in Canada, shall be eligible for election without payment of an entrance fee, but subject to the payment of an annual subscription of £7.10s or a semi-annual subscription of £5.
