Obtain from the druggist five cents' worth of tragacanth, which is enough for a year's use. Dissolve a spoon-ful of this in three times as much water. Let stand in a covered teacup for twelve hours. Then fill the cup with water, and you may apply the thin jelly which is made freely to your hands after each washing. A few drops of your favorite perfume and a little siycerine added to the jelly improve the lotion."


