MILLS'DEATH WAS NATURAL.

Oshawa Jury Does Not Blame Morphine for It.

Oshawa, May 11.-(Special.)-Death from natural causes was the verdict of Coroner Hoig's jury at the enquiry of Coroner Holg's jury at the enquiry to-day concerning the death of Sydney Mills, which occurred here last Sunday. The post mortem examination did not disclose the fact that morphine poison-have been sufficient to cause death as the organs of the deceased were in a most emaclated state, and the amount of morphine taken by mistake, if it really was morphine, would not have been sufficient to cause death. The doctors preferred to adopt the view that the man had succumbed naturally to disease of the liver and kidneys. The remains have been interred. Mills was widely known in two hemispheres in his capacity as transportation agent.
