Mr. John reports business higher and a tendency toward improvement in business is noticed, though it is hardly perceptible, and money is circulating more freely at Quebec, and trade in other parts of the country is better. The week has been a very quiet one at Montreal, owing to the holidays, and there is no change in the money market. The improvement at Toronto continues in the prices of corn and wheat, and has advanced and a large hay crop is assured."
