Imported Sires Prove the Best—Albert
and Order Are First and
Second.

DEMOCRAT AND THE DERBY.

Flying Bess Wins at New Orleans
and Zoroaster Third at San
Francisco.

The question of excessive racing of 2-year-
olds, which has been brought to the fore
by the proposed amendment to the rules of
the Jockey Club, has been discussed in the
columns of the Democrat and the Derby.

There are invariably two sides to
every question, and it would seem that in
this particular instance each side has its
share of advocates, says The New York
Telegraph.

It seems probable, however, that the re-
sult of Mr. Hittchcock's amendment will be
to strike a happy medium that will be sat-
isfactory to all concerned. The breeders,
of late years especially, have devoted much
time and study to the production of early
speed, because of the large stakes offered
by the racing associations for 2-year-olds,
and the consequent willingness of owners
to pay good prices for sires, with a view
to a quick return on their investments.

In view of this condition of affairs, the
Telegraph gives a table showing the sires
of winning 2-year-olds during the season
1899, which is somewhat for the season
up to and including Dec. 31.

Imp. Albert leads in the number
of races won by his get. He had 10 win-
ning representatives, which was a total of
23 races. He was followed by the late
winner of the Kentucky Derby, Flying Bess,
who had 9 winners, and 22 races, including
the rich Juvenile Champion at
Gravesend.

Imp. Order, with nine representatives,
won 22 races, and Imp. Albert done for
first honors. Lady Elite was the most
successful of his get, placing nine wins to
credit.

Florida had seven winning representatives,
and led the lot with a total of six wins.
Imp. Gallant comes next, with only
three winning representatives, but they
won a total of 26 races. 143 led won 11
races, Sidney Lucas, 10 races, and
Bessie, 10 races, and Bessie, 10 races.

Each of these sires has also won eight
winners. Golden Rule was Golden Rule's
most successful representative, winning
10 races, and Bessie, 10 races, and Bessie,

Hampton's record of 22 races by three
winning representatives, including Flying
Bess, is the best of the lot.
