**Court of Revision Re Local Improvements.**

Take notice that the Municipal Council  
of the Corporation of the Town of North

(d) concrete sidewalk 4 feet in width with necessary grading upon and along the northern side of said driveway from its intersection with the line of the easterly limit of the westerly lot No. 62 to the northerly side of said Albertus-avenue in a distance of 94 feet, more or less; also the grading of the road between said Albertus-avenue and the southerly side of said Glensview-avenue within the easterly limit of Lot No. 12, Plan M 87, on the south side, a distance of 180 feet, more or less;

(e) concrete sidewalk 4 feet in width with necessary grading upon and along the northern side of said driveway from its intersection with the line of the easterly limit of the westerly 5 feet of said Lot No. 12, Plan M 87, to the northerly side of said Glensview-avenue in a distance of 765 feet, for the sidewalk

(f) concrete sidewalk 4 feet in width with necessary grading upon and along the southerly side of Hawthorne-avenue

Westerly lot of Lot No. 39, westerly along the southerly side of said Hawthorne-avenue to its intersection with the line of the westerly limit of Lot No. 45, according to Plan M 25, a distance of 30 feet, more or less.
