Sir  
I have the honor to state that Mr. Mackay has made an application to purchase the water front of lot No 27 North side of Campbell St. Cornwall Schuylburg, and offers to pay thereon one hundred and twenty five dollars therefor. (\$125<sup>00</sup>.)

Mr. Mackay has already built a wharf on the waterfront in question.

I beg respectfully to recommend that a water front adjoining the water front occupied by Mr. L. B. Strey and extending Easterly ~~three~~ claims from the Eastern boundary of Mr. Strey's water front be sold to Mr. Mackay for one hundred and twenty five dollars.
