SUSPENSION OF RULES OF ORDER.

REVISION OF THE CANONS.

Moved by the Chancellor, seconded by Dr. Wilson, Q.C.,

That the Rules of Order be suspended to allow the introduction of a motion in relation to the Report of the Committee on the Revision of the Canons.—*Carried.*

Moved by the Chancellor, seconded by Dr. Wilson, Q.C.,

That the revised Canons, as reported by the Committee, be taken up as the first order of the day on Wednesday, the 19th of June, immediately after "Presenting Memorials," with the exception of the election of members of the Mission Board, and of Delegates to the Provincial Synod.

That in the consideration of the said Report the following rules be followed:—

(a) That every Canon which is reported by the Committee as unchanged in substance be adopted without debate.

(b) That every change reported by the Committee be considered, and adopted or rejected, and the draft, if necessary, amended accordingly.

(c) That no amendment other than those recommended by the Committee be admitted for discussion during the debate, but that any desired amendment be submitted independently of the submitted Canon.

(d) That the draft as finally adopted by the Synod be printed as an Appendix to the Journal of Synod.

Moved in amendment by the Rev. E. A. W. Hanington, seconded by the Rev. Rural Dean Nesbitt,

That clause (c) be struck out of the proposed resolution, and that the word "amended" be introduced in clause (b) so as to read "adopted, rejected, or amended.—*Lost.*

Moved in amendment by the Rev. Rural Dean Bogert, seconded by the Rev. Rural Dean Baker,

That clause (b) be amended by inserting the word "amended" after the word "adopted.—*Lost.*
