ing, and the vest may be shadow net or all-over lace.

Four yards of 44-inch crepe de chine will make the dress, and a yard of satin will be required for the belt, with 3/4 yard of lace for the vest.

With the exception of the stay, the pieces of the pattern are all placed either on a lengthwise fold of the material or a lengthwise thread. The importance of this may be realized when it is stated that any variation from the rule is likely to cause a break in the perfect lines of the dress.

The construction of the dress is not difficult, the waist being similar to other models that have appeared in this column, especially as regards the overlapping back. In making the skirt, though the upper front part of back gore should be finished on double "oo" perforation for an opening to pass the satin or ribbon through.

No material is used to greater extent than crepe for the making of dressy frocks for late spring and summer. Delicate shades of greenish yellow are in great demand, and they look very rich cabbaged with dark brown satin.

C.N. RAILWAY DEAL TAMMED THROUGH

Amendment For Six Months Hoist Defeated by Majority of 47—\$15,000,000 Wanted For C. T. P.—Larger Dry Dock For St. John—Redistribution

Ottawa, May 19—A motion to give the Mackenzie & Mann loan bill, presenting to them \$45,000,000, a six months' hoist, made by E. M. McDonald, was defeated tonight by a majority of 47.

There will be strenuous fighting before the measure is put through parliament and the Liberals will do their utmost to prevent this giving away of the people's money. Greater safeguards for the money loaned will be demanded.

Some G. T. P. officials yesterday waited upon the government with regard to the further issue of \$15,000,000 of federal guaranteed bonds to finance the completion of the mountain section of the road. It is said that the government is not opposed to giving the further grant.

In answer to a query tonight, Hon. Mr. Hazen said that negotiations were still pending between the Norton Griffiths Co. and the government which might eventually give St. John a larger dry dock.
