3. This Headquarters was subsequently advised verbally by the O.C., No.9 Active Company, V.C. of C. that as far as was known to his Headquarters, the distribution of the above-mentioned M.F.'s B. 483 were the only efforts made to apprehend the m/n soldier prior to 23 Oct 43.
