THE U. S. GOVERNMENT
TAKES OVER SHIPPING
 Washington, June 17.—The vast
 amount of steel merchant shipping un-
 der construction in American yards—
 probably 2,000,000 tons—will be taken
 over immediately by the government
 under power granted in an opinion of
 the war budget bill signed today by
 President Wilson.

The announcement was made today
 at a conference of the country's steel
 shipbuilders with the shipping board
 and its emergency fleet corporation.
 Shipping now on the yards will be
 hurried to completion by the institu-
 tion of a system of double and triple
 working shifts, and when the yards
 are cleared of present contracts the
 fleet corporation will begin construc-
 tion of its great fleet of standardized
 steel vessels.

MUCH SNOW IN WOODS
 Fredericton, June 17.—Adam Moore,
 the well known guide, states that there
 is still a great deal of snow in the
 woods along the valley of the Tobique.
 Mr. Moore does not look for a particu-
 larly successful fishing season. Many
 prominent United States sportsmen
 are unable to come to New Brunswick
 this year as they cannot leave their
 business in which more or less uncer-
 tainty exists because of their country
 entering the war. Bankers and brok-
 ers, especially, who usually come to
 New Brunswick each year will not be
 able to get away.
 The first fishing party from New
 York will arrive about July 1. Several
 prominent New Yorkers will fish sal-
 mon on the Tobique and Nepisiquit
 rivers.

LANG ENTERS THE ARMY
 Berlin, June 17.—At last Anton Lang,
 of Oberammergau, who is well known
 to many tourists as the Christus of the
 Passion play, has been called to serve
 in the Bavarian army. He appeared
 yesterday in field grey uniform before
 the garrison authorities of Augsburg.
 Lang, who is a potter by trade, was
 reported killed on the field of honor
 in 1915, and the papers of the whole
 world devoted columns to the obitu-
 ary of the famous peasant actor, but
 at that time he was safe and sound at
 Oberammergau.
