THE CONFERENCE TREASURER'S REPORT.

In presenting our first annual report, we are happy to say that the ministerial subscriptions are all paid in full. The following Districts have paid their assessments in full, viz.:—London, Chatham, Windsor, Ridgetown and Strathroy. There is a small deficiency reported by the St. Thomas District. Lts so small that we wonder that it was reported at all. There is a considerable deficiency reported by the Aylmer District, and larger ones by the Exeter and Sarnia Districts.

We find that some of the Financial Secretaries have retained all moneys till the meeting of the Conference, not forwarding amounts paid by Circuits, or the ministerial subscriptions paid at the Financial District Meetings. This is contrary to the 395th paragraph of the Discipline. It is an injury to the Fund, and we trust that it will not be repeated.
