McKeen, David. (Cape Breton.)

Ancestors came to Canada from Scot. and north of Irel., S. of the late Hon. William McKeen, M.L.C., N.S. B. at Mabou, N.S., and ed there, at Halifax and in Boston. M., 1st, 1867, Isabel, dau. of the late Henry Poole, Esq., Derby, Eng. (she died); 2nd, 1877, Frances M., dau. of the late William Lawson, merchant, Halifax. Is Agent and Treasurer of the Caledonia Coal and Railway Co. Has been Sub-Collector of Customs, U.S. Consular Agent, a Municpal Councillor and Warden of the Co. of Cape Breton. First returned to Part. at last g.e.—A Conservative.—Caledonia Mines, Little Glace Bay, N.S.

McMillan, Hugh. (Vaudrevil.)

Of Scottish parentage. S. of Lieut-Col. Donald Mc-Millan, who sat for Vaudreuil, in the Commons from 1867 to 1872. B at Rigaud. P.Q., 19 Dec., 1839. M., 11 Feb., 1862, Agnes, dau. of J. B. Mongenais, who sat for Vaudreuil, in the Commons, from 1878 to 1882. A trader. First returned to Parlt at g.e. 1882, and re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative.—Rigaud, P.Q.

McMillan, John. (South Huron.)

Family came to Can. from Kirkconnell, Dumfriesshire, Scot. B. there 19 July, 1823, and ed. at Parish Sch. M. 1st, 20 July, 1849, Miss Janet McMichael; 2nd, 3rd Nov., 1868, Mrs. Jameson. Is a farmer. Apptd. a mem. of the Agricultural Commission of Ont., 3 April, 1880. Has been Reeve of the Tp. of Hullett. Sat in the Commons from g.e. 1882, until Dec. 1883, when he resigned. Re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal.—Constance, Ont.
