A Message was brought from the House of Commons by their Clerk, to return the Bill intituled: "An Act respecting the High Court of Justice for Ontario" and to acquaint this House that they have passed the said Bill, with several amendments, to which they desire the concurrence of the Senate.

The said amendments were then read by the Clerk, as follows:—

Page 1, line 13.—Leave out from "follows" to line 3, in line 31.

Page 1, line 32.—Leave out "of any" and leave out from "the" to "may" in line 37, and insert "High Court of Justice of Ontario."

Page 1, line 40.—Leave out from "trial "to "the" in page 2, line 10. Page 2, line 14.—Leave out from "Court" to "8" in line 29.

Page 3, line 5.—After "the" insert "Chapter of the" and leave out "Statute" and insert "Statutes."

Page 3, line 18.—Leave out from "require" to "repealed" inclusive, in line 28. On motion of the Honorable Sir Alexander Campbell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Plumb, it was

Ordered. That the said amendments be taken in consideration at the next sitting

of the House.
