**BILL.**

An Act to amend the Act authorizing the Quebec Turnpike Road Trustees to acquire possession of Dorchester Bridge, in so far as regards a certain road therein mentioned.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient in the manner Preamble.  
 hereinafter provided, the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to* 12 Vict c. 115 cited.  
 "authorize and enable the Trustees of the Quebec Turnpike  
 5 "Roads to acquire and assume the possession and property  
 "of the Bridge called Dorchester Bridge, and for other  
 "purposes;" Be it therefore enacted, &c., That for and notwithstanding anything in the fifth section of the said Act  
 10 contained, the provisions of the Ordinance mentioned in  
 the said Act and the powers of the Trustees appointed Powers of  
 Quebec Turnpike Trustees  
 to extend over seven miles of  
 Charlesbourg Village of St.  
 Pierre Road.  
 under the authority thereof, shall extend to the road leading from the Church of the Parish of Charlesbourg to the Village of St. Pierre, for the distance of seven miles, instead of one mile and a half only as in and by the said  
 15 section provided; and the said section shall be construed  
 as if the said road for the space of two miles had been mentioned next after the road in the said section described as the "Road leading from the Bridge over the River  
 "Montmorency near the great fall of the said River, as  
 20 "far as the boundary line between the Parishes of L'Ange  
 "Gardien and Chateau Richer, in continuation of the  
 "road seventhly described in the said Ordinance."
