- 23. Any operator of the said Telegraph Line, or person employed Penalty on by the said Telegraph Company, divulging the contents of a private divulging despatch, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds, or to imprisonment not exceeding three months, or both, in the discretion of the Court before which the conviction shall be had.
- 24. Any person who shall wilfully or maliciously injure, molest or Penalty on destroy any of the said lines, posts, piers or abutments, or the material persons in or property belonging thereto, or in any way disturb the working of line.

 10 the said line of Telegraph; shall, on conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and be punished by a fine not exceeding ten pounds, or imprisonment not exceeding one month, or both, at the discretion of the Court before which the conviction shall be had.
- 25. The works of the Company shall be commenced within three Commence-15 years, and completed from Quebec to Labrador or to the eastern end of the ment of Island of Anticosti, within six years from the passing of this Act, works, &c otherwise the Act, shall be null and, void.
