permit the free Importation of raw Goat Skins into this Kingdom, for a limited Time, which was to continue in Koice from the Twentieth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-sive, sor the Term of Kive Bears, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which, by another Ast, made in the Twentieth Bear of his said Wajesty's Reign, was surther continued until the Twentieth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-sive, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby surther continued, from the Expiration thereof, until the Twentieth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and ninety, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.
