WHEREAS the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs by his

Indenture of Lease bearing date the 28th Oct. 1892
for the consideration in the said Lease mentioned demised to

Nelson Cady
all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land lying and being in
the Township of Caradoc in

the County of Middlesex containing by
admeasurement 28 ³/₄ acres be the same more less, being

composed of The West half of the
old School Land, being parts of
South half of Lots Two and
Three, Range Five of the
Caradoc Indian Reserve
