Honourable Charles Stewart.

We have received a report from the Indian Agent at Kenora that a timber licensee on the Lac Seul Reserve is conducting a wasteful operation and leaving a serious fire hazard due to the manufacture of hewn ties in the bush. I think it advisable to employ a timber cruiser to visit the reserve and make an inspection, and I have to ask you for the name of a thoroughly competent man to undertake this work.
