With reference to your letter of the 28th Ult., and to the Petition of the Restouche Indians enclosed therein I have to request that you will inform those Indians of the provisions made by the 10 Section of the Act 32-33 Vic: Chap 31 in regard to Indian Chiefs, and that in accordance therewith those Chiefs of whom they complain must be proved by Affidavits of reliable persons to have been guilty of dishonesty, intemperance, or immorality in order to admit of their being removed from the position that occupy - The numbers, and locality of the lots to which they allude as having been improperly disposed of should also be shown
