WHEREAS Clause (a) of Section 8 of The Canadian Wheat Board Act 1935, provides that it shall be the duty of the Canadian Wheat Board established under the said Act, to fix the price to be paid to the producers for wheat delivered to the said Board as by the said Act provided, subject to the approval of the Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS the Canadian Wheat Board, established under the said Act as aforesaid, has fixed a price of eighty-seven and one-half cents (87½) per bushel for wheat graded as No. 1 Northern at Fort William as the basic price for wheat, delivered to the Board as provided by the said Act, the price of other grades of wheat to be fixed by the Board on the basis of the price for No. 1 Northern Wheat delivered at Fort William as aforesaid:

NOW THEREFORE His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Right Honourable the Prime Minister, for the Minister of Trade and Commerce, is pleased to approve the said price as fixed by the said Canadian Wheat Board and it is hereby approved accordingly.
